
An authorized "partnership agent" in your agency should fill out an order for each individual or family to be assisted, listing items authorized for assistance, i.e., dress, pants, toaster, chair, table, etc. Quantities requested should be spelled out for clarity, i.e., one, two, three, etc. The agency may limit the value of the order by writing "not to exceed \$(amount)" on the order form. Write "End of Order" on the line following the last item draw a diagonal line through the unused lines. Sign the order, put it and the vouchers in an envelope, seal it and give it to the individual or family. The yellow or pink copy of the order is retained by the agency.

The agency should inform the individual or family that the items available for assistance are clothing and/or As Is items and certain New Value items (limited to socks, underwear, towels, sheets, and blankets) and that the Deseret Industries store will not deliver. The individual or family may take the completed order form to any Deseret Industries. When the individual or family arrives at the Deseret Industries store, they should ask for the Manager on Duty and present the sealed envelope to that manager. The Manager on Duty will sign the order and give the individual or family instructions on shopping and checking out. Any unused vouchers will be retained by the Manager, and will not be available for further use. **Consistent with our mutual objective of voucher recipients becoming self-reliant and increasing feelings of self-worth, please encourage them, where appropriate, to offer some level of volunteer service as a reciprocal contribution to the community (churches, agencies, etc.).**

We would appreciate hearing from you periodically with any positive experiences you might have in this endeavor, including any photographs, if available, that communicate the impact of this partnership on beneficiaries. Please refer to the partnership by the above project number on any correspondence.

We appreciate your efforts to assist the needy in your community.
